


558 people received completely free care
1,358 medical encounters and 380 case management appointments


Hope Clinic provided over 12,000 minutes of interpreter services to help patients communicate clearly and engage fully in their care.

Over half of patients (52.1%) reported they would forgo necessary medical care without access to Hope Clinic, while an additional 22.9% said they would turn to emergency rooms even for non-emergency health needs. Affordable options remain scarce and difficult to access.
